New Testament I

Historical overview of the New Testament, showing the roots of the gospel in the OT and linking the epistles into the Acts narrative.

New Testament II

Examining the cultural context of the Roman world and its impact on the language and structure of the NT. Introduction to the apostolic church

Track 2

Bible Study Methods

Detailed course on why and how to study the Bible, including hands-on training in practical study steps and methods.

Evangelism

Learning to follow Christ's example and command to expand God's Kingdom, including practical evangelism tools.

Hermeneutics

More in-depth course on Bible study methods including more focus on biblical interpretation and development of Christian world view.

Discipleship

Practical training on how to bring along a new believer in the ways of following Christ. Introduction to the basic spiritual disciplines.

Counseling 101

Practical training in Biblical counseling, with a focus on helping fellow believers to look past their struggles and find fulfillment in Christ.

Track 1

This is the more foundational track of Impact University, designed for Christians who have never received systematic Bible training. If you are a new believer or simply want to shore up the foundations of your faith, we recommend starting with Track 1. With dedication, Track 1 can be completed over a two-year period, at which point Track 2 will begin again to allow those who completed Track 1 to continue in Track 2.

Track 2

This track is designed for those who already have a solid basis in biblical and doctrinal teaching. If you have been walking with God for some time and feel he is calling you to take on more responsibility in some area of service or leadership, then Track 2 is for you.
