Track 2

S.H.A.P.E.

Survey of World Religions & Cults

Track 1

This is the more foundational track of Impact University, designed for Christians who have never received systematic Bible training. If you are a new believer or simply want to shore up the foundations of your faith, we recommend starting with Track 1.

Track 2

This track is designed for those who already have a solid basis in biblical and doctrinal teaching. If you have been walking with God for some time and feel he is calling you to take on more responsibility in some area of service or leadership, then Track 2 is for you.
